Day 1 / March 12, 2025 Depart Canada

Day 2 / March 13, 2025 Arrival in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil - Free Day - Welcome Dinner (B,D)

Touch down in the vibrant city of Rio de Janeiro shortly after midnight. Upon arrival, you'll be greeted by our local tour manager, who will arrange your transfer to the hotel. Your accommodation for the night of March 12 has been pre-arranged for your convenience. Have the full day to catch up on your sleep, take a dip in the Atlantic Ocean or sunbath on the world-famous Copacabana and Leme beaches, and maybe checkout a local bar or restaurant for lunch and explore the area on your own.

Tonight, enjoy a welcome celebration, starting with a local mojito at the pre-dinner cocktail party to cheer the beginning of your wonderful vacation, followed by an early (by local standards) welcome dinner.

If you are still up for more excitement after dinner, checkout some local bars with live music and dancing on your own, either by the beach or downtown Rio via a taxi ride. You will be just in time to experience the liveliness of the city's nightlife.

Day 3 / March 14, 2025 City Tour, Carnival Experience (B,L)

This morning, prepare to immerse yourself in the infectious rhythm of Rio, a city renowned for its dynamic landscape, beach life, majestic bay, towering mountains, culinary delights and laid-back ambiance. We meet our local guide and coach for a half day city tour, see sights such as the Catedral Metropolitana de Sao Sebastiao, Aqueduto da Carioca, and the Escadaria Selaron. Lunch included at local restaurant.

This afternoon, we invite you to an unforgettable experience behind the scenes of the Rio de Janeiro carnival, and a time travel through the historical streets of Little Africa, which hides the secrets to this party!

Rio is internationally recognized for its grandiose Carnival and Samba Parade. But what most people don't know is how the show is created. On this tour, you will get to know the origins of this famous party visiting different places: the Sambódromo and its cultural center, the revitalized port area where samba has its roots, the charming artistic neighborhood of Morro da Conceição and the historic site Pedra do Sal, birthplace of samba. You will learn about the period of slavery in Brazil and Afro-Brazilian culture, fundamentals of modern Carnival. The highlight of the tour is a visit to a samba school studio to experience the preparations for Rio's carnival behind the scenes. We will witness first-hand the impressive work of design and production of the magnificent floats and costumes used in "The Greatest Show on Earth".

Transfer back to the hotel afterwards. Dinner on your own tonight.

Day 4 / March 15, 2025 Christ the Redeemer – Sugar Loaf Mountain – Embarkation (B,L,D) Checkout of hotel after breakfast. Meet local guide and coach and see the Christ the Redeemer and Sugar Loaf Mountain.

Set off on a private guided tour to the most emblematic postcards of Rio! We will embark on a 30-minute tram ride uphill to the top of Corcovado Mountain. The summit offers the best views of the entire city and features the iconic statue of Christ the Redeemer, with its wide-open arms.

After a stop for a quick lunch at local restaurant, we will head to the famous Sugarloaf Mountain with a fast pass, from where we'll stop at a lookout point that offers spectacular views of the Atlantic Ocean and Rio's surrounding mountains. From Morro da Urca (220m) we take a second cable-car lift to the Sugarloaf hill summit (396m), where we enjoy unparalleled 360-degree views of the surrounding areas and a unique sunset.

Day 5 / March 16, 2025 Buzios, Brazil (B,L,D)

Relax, slow down and enjoy a beach day at Maceió. Once a hidden gem, Macieo has recently become a haven for beach goers in Brazil and around the world. When it's time to step out of the sun, shop for handcrafted goods at Mercado do Artesanato or grab a bite at one of the city's many restaurants.

Stretching across three islands, Recife's cityscape is accented with scenic inlets, canals and bridges. What began as a scattering of fishing shacks in the 16th century is now a vibrant city that boasts delicious cuisine, colourful markets and a lively nightlife. Just to the north of Recife, you can dive into the history of the region with a trip to Olinda. Built on steep hillsides overlooking the Atlantic Ocean, the small town offers incredible vistas as you tour its 16th and 18th century historic sites. For those interested in the tradition of Brazil's Carnival, stop by the unique Mamulengo Museum to glimpse some of the handmade puppets used in the town's famous parades.

Day 10 – 12 / March 21 – 23, 2025 At Sea (B,L,D)

Immerse yourself in the rhythm of the sea during these leisurely days aboard the ship. Savor the tranquility as you lounge under the sun, dip into the pool, or gaze upon the vast ocean.
